The CILAS will be busy doing crafts this month, as well as enjoying corn beef and cabbage for St. Patty's day.



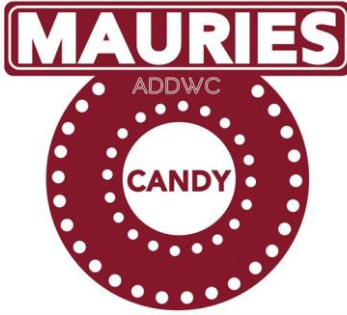
**RECYCLING NEWS**
